Bleeding

Heavy or increased bleeding

Pain

Pain or swelling that increases or continues beyond 2 or 3 days

Antibiotics

A reaction to the antibiotics

SUPPORT

It is normal to experience some discomfort for several days after tooth extraction, but contact us right away if you have any concerns.



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POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS AFTER

Extraction



During the first 24 hours

1.KEEP BITING ON THE GAUZE FOR THE NEXT 30MIN

2.DON'T SMOKE IN THE NEXT 48HRS

3.DON'T DRINK ALCOHOL IN THE NEXT 48HRS

4.DON'T PERFORM ANY EXERCISES IN THE NEXT 24 HRS

5.DO NOT RINSE YOUR MOUTH IN THE NEXT 24HRS

6.BRUSH GENTLY

7.BE VERY CAREFUL NOT TO DISLUDGE ANY BLOOD CLOT IN THE TOOTH SOCKET

8.APPLY AN ICE BAG TO REDUCE SWELLING

9.TAKE REGULAR PAINKILLERS IF NEEDED, AVOID ASPIRIN.

After the first 24 hours

1.BEGIN TO EAT AS NORMAL AS SOON AS IT'S COMFORTABLE

2.RESUME BRUSHING AND FLOSSING, BUT CLEAN GENTLY AROUND THE SITE FOR ABOUT A WEEK.

3. CONTINUE TO TAKE ANTIBIOTICS AS PRESCRIBED FOR THE INDICATED LENGHT OF TIME

4. STITCHES SHOULD BE REMOVED AFTER 7-10 DAYS UNLESS THEY ARE DISSOLVABLE
